

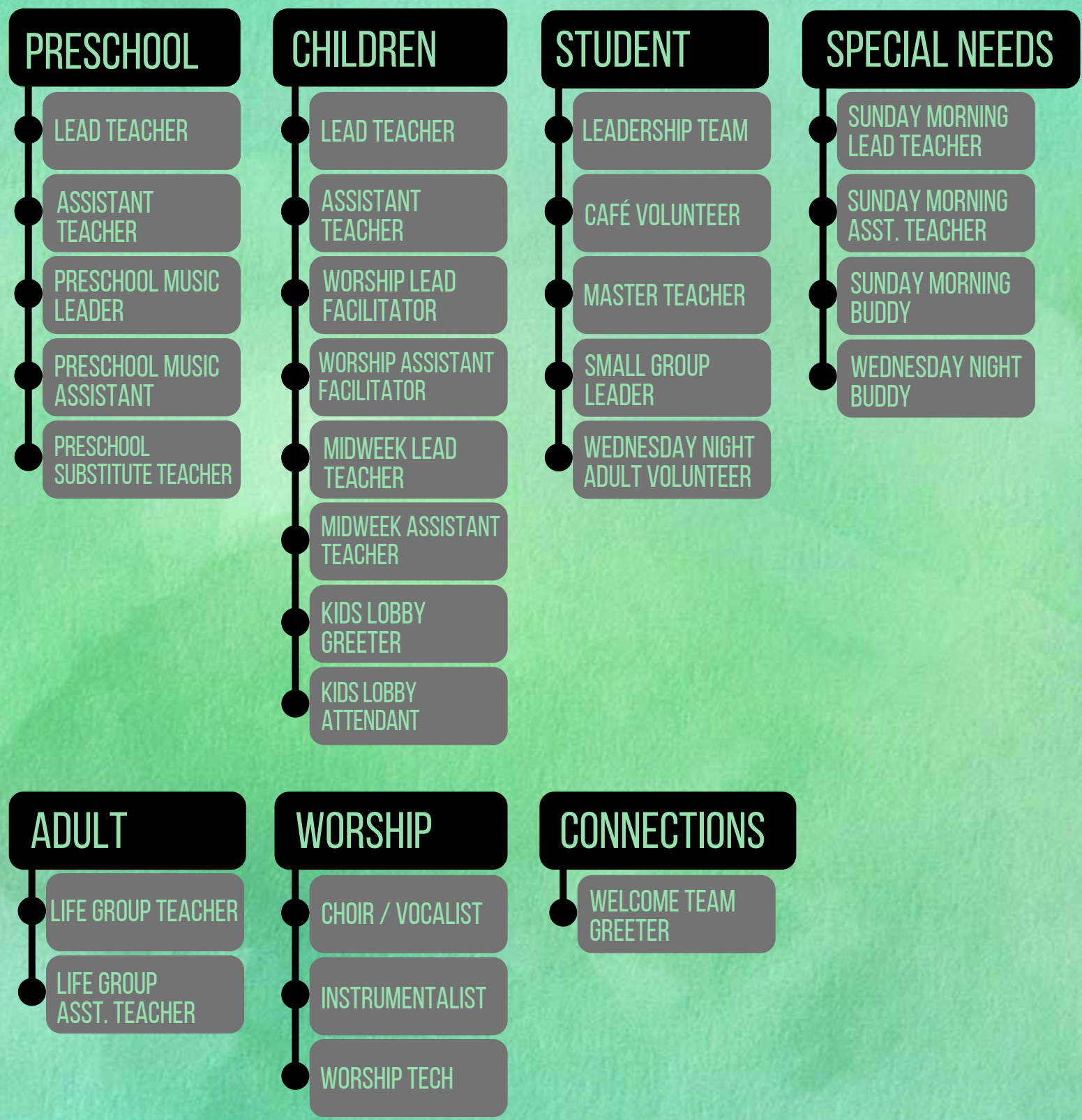
DEAR HEIGHTS FAMILY,

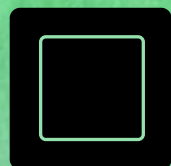

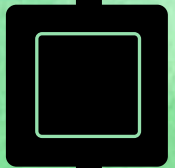
PROCESS & TIMELINE FOR SERVE



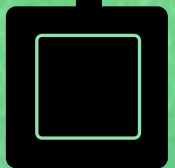

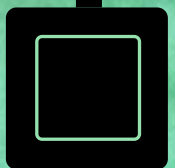

PRESCHOOL SERVE

SERVING: CHILDREN AGES BIRTH THROUGH KINDERGARTEN

OUR PRESCHOOL VOLUNTEER POSITIONS ARE RESERVED FOR INDIVIDUALS PASSIONATE ABOUT SERVING OUR PRESCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN. YOUR ROLE IS TO PROVIDE A SAFE, LOVING ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH THE CHILDREN AND PARENTS FEEL COMFORTABLE. CLASSROOM TIME IS RESERVED FOR AGE-APPROPRIATE LESSONS IN WHICH THE VOLUNTEERS WILL CONNECT WITH THE CHILDREN. WORKERS SHOULD STRIVE TO BUILD MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS WITH EACH INDIVIDUAL CHILD.



LEAD TEACHER

THE LEAD TEACHER POSITION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR LEADING THE LESSON AND ACTIVITIES DURING THE DESIGNATED VOLUNTEER TIME. THE INDIVIDUAL WILL PREPARE AND GUIDE BIBLE LEARNING ACTIVITIES FROM THE PROVIDED BIBLE CURRICULUM. THESE VOLUNTEERS WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH THE PRESCHOOL DIRECTOR TO FULFILL THE DESIRED PURPOSE OF SERVING THE CHILDREN.

**ASSISTANT TEACHER**

THE ASSISTANT TEACHER POSITION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSISTING THE LEAD TEACHER IN YOUR DESIGNATED ROOM. THE ASSISTANT WILL HELP WITH CRAFTS AND ACTIVITIES AS DIRECTED BY THE LEAD TEACHER. THIS INCLUDES CLOSELY INTERACTING WITH THE CHILDREN TO DIRECT THEIR ATTENTION TO THE TASK AT HAND. AT TIMES THE ASSISTANT WILL BE ASKED TO TAKE ON THE ROLE OF THE LEAD TEACHER IF SOMETHING UNEXPECTED OCCURS.

THIS POSITION LEADS THE CHILDREN THROUGH THE SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES. ULTIMATELY THE ROLE OF THIS POSITION IS TO BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE CHILDREN AND ENCOURAGE THE CHILDREN IN THEIR SPIRITUAL WALK WITH CHRIST. THIS SERVICE TIME IS A MORE TRADITIONAL “SUNDAY SCHOOL” ROLE WITH SCHOOL-LIKE ACTIVITIES, PAPERS, AND TEACHING STYLE.

THIS IS IDEAL FOR THOSE WHO PREFER TO DIRECT CHILDREN INDIVIDUALLY, RATHER THAN AS A GROUP, TO MAINTAIN ORDER IN THE CLASSROOM. ULTIMATELY THE ROLE OF THIS POSITION IS TO BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE CHILDREN AND ENCOURAGE THE CHILDREN IN THEIR SPIRITUAL WALK WITH CHRIST. THIS SERVICE TIME IS A MORE TRADITIONAL “SUNDAY SCHOOL” ROLE WITH SCHOOL-LIKE ACTIVITIES, PAPERS, AND TEACHING STYLE.
